

2008 Yard Waste Recycling Guidelines

Gallegos Sanitation is ready to start collecting your yardwaste. The past 9 years we have operated a yardwaste recycling program, made available only to current GSI customers. Please review the information below for a list of acceptable items and preparation instructions. Please note that the items on the lower section of this flyer cause load contamination. For this reason, if these items are found in your yardwaste container, we cannot service your container until the contaminants are removed. You may include an additional 35 - gallons of yardwaste per week in an additional can or as one bundle of branches (for a total of 100 gallons per week). Please note that all the rules apply to the extra 35 gallons as well.

Do Recycle

- ⇒ Grass Clippings Place loose in cart or in a separate 30 - gallon trash can.
- ⇒ Shrubs Cut up and place in cart.
- ⇒ Tree Branches Cut up and place in cart or set next to it. No more than 4' length x 1 1/2' diameter.
- ⇒ Flowers
- ⇒ Weeds
- ⇒ Garden Waste
- ⇒ Leaves
- ⇒ Food Waste (No Bones) **NEW!**

Don't Recycle

- ⇒ Plastic Bags Not even for grass clippings or leaves.
- ⇒ Plastic This includes plant containers.
- ⇒ Refined Wood i.e. fence boards, construction or any other treated wood materials.
- ⇒ Paper
- ⇒ Metal Cans or Glass Bottles
- ⇒ Dirt or Rock Sod is acceptable if ALL dirt is removed.
- ⇒ Trash of any kind Even a little bit is considered contamination.
- ⇒ Chemicals Including paint and other household items
